624 SCHOOL BOARD RECOGNITION OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish procedures for recognizing student achievement.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Since recognition is a motivator to the recipient, as well as being good publicity for the school district, it shall be the policy of the school board to recognize examples of student achievement at regularly scheduled board meetings.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

The superintendent should be responsible for developing a list of significant awards to be recognized, to identify recipients, and to schedule the recognition at board meetings.
