 - a) School Projects:
 1. Fountains/Water-Bottle Filling stations now expected in summer. 3rd Grade donated \$727, to fund an additional filling station, or two more if I use school money to fund the new tile work (4 total). Fund another two from 5K?
 2. Funded and about to order: 1 SEM Laptop & soccer goals from O.S. fundraiser.
 - b) Future school projects. In addition this list, are there any others you feel we should consider? **Bolded items are priority.**
 1. 3rd Grade will wait for iPad Lab until next year (\$9,000). Look at one or two I pad labs
 2. Additional SEM laptops (3 more to make 4 total). Check into 100% for kids from America First.
 3. Additional iPad for Dot/Dash robots. Check into 100% for kids from America First. Currently has 2, wants a third.
 4. **Security camera on west portable alley**
 5. **LED lighting on portables to light west parking lot.**
 6. **Front & monitor speakers for auditorium, with second amplifier.**
 7. Additional 8-channel Biamp mixer for more wireless microphone inputs.
 8. Additional wireless microphones for the stage (possibly this year).
 9. Eventually replace all ceiling speakers (24) in the gym
 10. **Cement pad for east bike racks** (near east entry or by 1st grade windows).
