    - Mid year DIBELS test scores We did not reach goal of 3% increase
    - SAGE and CRT Interim training

6. **Trust Lands Items, Budget, or Updates**
  - a) Review proposed / actual budget for 2016/2017 Estimate \$16,000 more next year.
  - b) Student Improvement Plan for 2017/2018
    - a. Mr. King and Mrs. Pendergast analyzed data and concluded that as a school Language Arts needs improvement in comprehension and vocabulary. As a school overall math needs improvement in math facts.
    - b. We plan to measure growth throughout the year to evaluate progress toward goals. Arts can be measured by SRI and math can be measured by testing math facts.
    - c. This year SAGE in Language Arts: 43% proficient and 43 MGP (medium growth percentile). This year SAGE in Math 44% proficient and 38 MGP
    - d. Mr. King explained Blended Learning using technology and a Station Rotation Model and that some teachers are planning to try it next year.
