

## **ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCILS AND COMMITTEES**

The Superintendent discusses plans, policies, and procedures with the administrative staff and for this purpose may set up such councils and committees as deemed desirable.

The groups established or authorized by the Superintendent may be ad hoc (for the purpose of studying a particular issue) or may be commissioned to assist in a broad range of studies. Groups are strictly advisory in nature and are subject to the same general guidelines on research, release of information, and so forth as are established for advisory groups to the New Hanover County Board of Education (Board).

The Superintendent reports to the Board the decisions and recommendations made by such groups when these require Board action or are a matter of Board policy. However, in making recommendations to the Board, the Superintendent is not bound by the decisions of such bodies.
