

## **STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS**

The New Hanover County Board of Education, recognizing both its responsibility towards quality teacher training as well as the contribution that student teachers and interns can make to the school system, encourages its administration to cooperate with teacher training institutions in the placement of student teachers in the public schools.

School System teachers who aspire to supervise student teachers must first fulfill their primary responsibility, which is to educate students in their charge. In addition, they must demonstrate to their principal that they are able and willing to meet these additional responsibilities.

The Board authorizes the administration to honor reasonable rules, regulations, and training guidelines of the sending institution. In all arrangements made with sending institutions, the school system will have the privilege of interviewing and accepting or rejecting individual trainee candidates.

The school administration will set up evaluation procedures for student teachers and interns that meet the requirements of the sending institution and comply with the policies of the Board of Education.
