

STAFF INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING

The Board of Education recognizes the need for employee participation in decision making for the school system.

The Superintendent or designee will develop with the administrative staff various channels for the intercommunication of ideas regarding the operation of the schools. The Superintendent will review with care the counsel given by employees and will inform the Board of such counsel in presenting recommendations for the development of new policies, or the deletion, or amendment of existing ones.

In compliance with federal laws, New Hanover County Schools administers all educational programs, employment activities and admissions without discrimination because of race, religion, national or ethnic origin, color, age, military service, disability or gender, except where exemption is appropriate and allowed by law.
