Summer School Program Expectations

Summer School is an opportunity for secondary students to strengthen skills, retrieve credit and build flexibility int schedules. High school students can earn .5 or 1.0 credit (course dependent) per class in approximately six weeks. St must make a serious commitment to the experience in order to successfully complete the requirements. The following policies and regulations ensure an optimal learning environment that protects the safety and rights of all students. Attendance and Tardies Students must attend every day of Summer School. Northshore School District requires 90 "Content" hours for excredit and 45 hours for credit retrieval. More than two (2) absences may result in loss of credit and an "Fro ot transcript. Students must arrive on time to class since detention can be assigned for tardies. Three tardies equal senence. Excessive tardies that equal two (2) absences may result in loss of credit. General Campus Regulations 1. Summer School maintains a closed campus. Once students arrive on campus, they cannot leave during bre between classes. Visitors must check in at the summer school office. 2. Students may not disrupt other classes or endanger people or school property. 3. Students shall wear clothing that is appropriate and preserves modesty, no bare midriff or underwear shall clothing with print or pictures that involve drugs, tobacco, sex, or improper language will not be permitted at St School. All students shall wear shoes. 4. Inappropriate, rude, or disrespectful language is unacceptable. 5. All students will be in a classroom during class time. No loitering is permitted in the halls, parking lots, or othe of the school premises. Personal business must be conducted during transition time. 6. If a student is caught cheating on a class assignment or exam, the student will receive a failing grade for assignment or exam. Make-up or retake is not permitted.
