HIRING

All employees must have an employee ID number before beginning work. This includes substitute custodians. There are no exceptions to this rule.

DRESS CODE

All employees must dress in accordance with the requirements stated in the code of ethics and the information listed below:

- Hair should be styled in a clean and well-groomed manner
- No startling or disruptive hairdo's or colors
- Shoes must be worn at all times (Closed toe shoes are required for custodial employees)
- Clothing must be of modest design. All shirts must have sleeves! No tank tops, bare midriffs, bare stomach, off-the-shoulder blouses, backless or sheer fabrics. Visible undergarments including bra straps are NOT allowed. Entire torso must be covered at all times
- Pants that expose buttocks, visible undergarments, or sag below the hip bone will not be allowed
- No deep scooped necklines or exposed cleavage allowed
- Short shirts, short skirts, and short dresses will not be accepted. They must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- Clothing that promotes or displays illegal items such as tobacco, alcohol, obscene, or inappropriate material will not be permitted
- Shirts must be worn at all times while at our schools
