Obtain Gull Lake Textbook Reimbursement form 4. At end of semester, attempt to sell back/return book. 5. Turn in both receipts (beginning/end of semester) and any unsold textbooks to Gull Lake Administration Building for reimbursement if funds are remaining. 		Funds typically not available
