PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Nurse Administrator program builds on the knowledge and competencies of baccalaureate education and experience as a practicing nurse and prepares the graduate to be a nurse administrator.

PROGRAM COMPLETION TIMEFRAME/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The MSN may be completed in 2 years and is offered in a hybrid format with classes meeting one evening a week.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduate of an accredited (ACEN or CCNE) nursing program
 - Minimum GPA 3.0
 - Active, unencumbered RN license
 - One year RN experience (preferred)
 - Three professional references
 - Application to Bethel College/MSN program
- Complete an application at www.bethelcollege.edu/graduate_program

FINANCIAL INCENTIVES

- Available to Bethel BSN and BSN-C students
- Must enroll in the MSN program within 15 months of BSN graduation
- MSN program admission criteria must be met

Only six (6) credit hours of approved course work may be transferred in. Administrator track students may opt to take the pre-requisite courses through Straighter Line or test out through the College Board CLEP test and receive equivalent credit.
