Parents as Teachers offer developmental screenings for children 0 – 3 years of age who do not currently receive home visits. The ASQ (Ages & Stages Questionnaire) offers a system of screening infants and young children for developmental delays during the crucial early years of life.

Screenings are offered once a month as follows:
