Levels are determined by the use of multiple data points (historical data, predictive data, formative assessments, and summative assessments) and professional input from teachers, curriculum coordinators, and administrators.

CORE CLASSES

The core content classes develop literacy, numeracy, and other content specific skills essential for a well rounded academic base.

- 48 minute class periods
- Language Arts 2 periods per day
- Math 1 period per day
- Science 1 period per day
- Social Studies 1 period per day

UNIFIED ARTS

The unified arts classes support the core content area classes and provide an exploratory experience.
