## Wiseburn School District Measure A and Measure AA Bond Oversight Committee Meeting Minutes February 10, 2014

Russell Kehl called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

- Review and approval of minutes from September 23, 2013 Measure A Bond Oversight Committee and Measure AA Bond Oversight Committee meetings.
  - a. In response to a question about the Measure A revenue, Dave Wilson provided the following information: Measure A received \$3,291,611.82 in revenue since July 1, 2012. Below are the revenue streams that make up the \$3,291,611.82:

#### Discussion

- Cabrillo project (close out with DSA) asked Flewelling & Moody to wrap up paperwork with DSA.
- Burnett MPR: major work is complete, working on finishing touches.
- Dana Snack Stand/Restroom: making several upgrades to meet Health Department standards.
- <u>Utah Property</u> (background info): intended purpose was for District Office and Maintenance Facility. District received 3 years worth of rent from former owner. Built new Maintenance Facility on Dana property for \$3.25 million. NSB offered to buy property on Utah for \$6.5 million (same as what District paid for it). District received \$1.6 million from sale of Utah property, and will receive annual interest of \$98,250 on balance due for 3 years (with option for 4<sup>th</sup> year). Balance is due in 2016.

3) Review of Measure AA Revenues, Expenditures and Fund Balance as of 12/31/13:

#### Discussion

- Issued last series of bonds, interest rate 3%, payback ratio of 1.6 to 1, financed over 19 years.
- Balfour Beatty is providing pre-construction services.

## 4) Update on Current Projects

### High School Project

- 1. Funding gap of \$32 million. Currently have \$37.2 million for \$60 million project. Potential sources of additional funding:
  - a. Qualify for approximately \$29 million in state matching funds. Need to wait for state to pass another General Obligation bond. There are ~\$1 billion in projects waiting for state matching money.
  - b. If Centinela Valley seeks another bond, Wiseburn will ask for a share (up to \$18 million) of the bond money. Dr. Johnstone will discuss with the Centinela Valley superintendent.
  - c. Joint-use facility fees (pool and gym). State promotes joint use facilities, provides 50% back in matching money. Wiseburn would have priority use of joint facility.
- 2. Need to install passive Methane gas collection center (DTSC requirement).

Burnett Mini Modernization Project: Replace ceiling tile, install security system/cameras, rubber surface for playground, new carpeting and door hardware.

# 5) Other Discussion / Questions

- a. What is the back-up plan if don't get state matching money for High School project? Will do project in phases, and keep existing DaVinci sites open. (Note: pool is part of Phase 1)
- b. Boeing support for math program at Dana (Center for Math & Science).
- c. Why is Measure CL not on list of potential sources of additional funding for High School project? Measure CL was not intended to be used for construction.
