General Information

OUR PROGRAMS

AFTER SCHOOL covers the below programs offered to Avenues students, Monday through Friday, from school dismissal to 5:30 p.m. All the programs listed below fall under the After School umbrella.

SPECIALTY CLASSES are offered to all Avenues students, from Monday through Friday from school dismissal to 5:30 p.m. Classes cover a wide variety of topics, including dance, art, sports and more; costs vary from class to class.

PRIVATE MUSIC LESSONS are available to students in Pre-K through 12th grade. Avenues has partnered with Opus Music School to include classes for trumpet, saxophone, violin, guitar, flute, clarinet, piano, drums, voice and more.

PLAYLAB is the general after school care for students in nursery through 5th grade. Activities during this time include art, cooking, group games and outdoor play. PlayLab is offered Monday through Friday from dismissal to 5:30 p.m. Enrollment is entirely flexible. Families may enroll students on a daily or multi-day basis.

SPECIALTY CLASSES FOR ADULTS are offered to Avenues parents. They will provide the opportunity to participate in English conversation workshops, Spanish lessons and Aerojazz.

ADVENTURES IN ART

ARTISTS' HUB

BRAZILIAN JIU JITSU

CAPOEIRA

PlayLab

PlayLab is the general after-school care for students in nursery through 5th grade. Activities during this time include art, cooking, group games and outdoor play.

PlayLab is offered Monday through Friday from dismissal to 5:30 p.m. Enrollment is entirely flexible. Families may enroll students on a daily or multi-day basis.

Students may also attend PlayLab occasionally. Occasional visits must be scheduled at least one day advance through extensions-sp@avenues.org.

If a student needs to wait for a specialty class or stay late after one (no later than 5:30 p.m.) he or she may join your peers in to PlayLab activities for a shorter period of time.

According to Avenues policy, Primary Division students may not be on campus without adult supervision.

Private Music Lessons

Private music lessons are offered to students in pre-K through 12th grade. Lessons are offered in 30-minute blocks. We have partnered with Opus Music School, which specializes in private lessons for a wide variety of musical instruments.

We offer the study of trumpet, saxophone, violin, guitar, flute, clarinet, piano, drums, voice and more. Private music lessons will run from September through June, with a recital at the end of the year.

Private music lessons have a separate registration process and managed directly through Opus Music School. If you are interested in private music lessons, please email musiclessons-sp@avenues.org.

Policies and Procedures

AFTER SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Nursery - 1st Grade: students will be escorted from their classroom to the After School Hub (Hub is a meeting point room for students and their after-school teachers). Their After School teacher will collect them for their activity. A healthy snack is provided around 2:00 pm.

2nd - 5th Grade: students will walk from their classrooms to the After School Hub (Hub is a meeting point room for students and their after-school teachers). Once they are there, they will have a healthy snack provided by our staff around 3:00. Their After School teacher will take students for their activity.

6th - 10th Grade: there will be a 30-minute break between school dismissal and specialty classes. Students will have time to change (if necessary) and have a snack (they can bring their own healthy snack or go to Connect). Students are responsible for arriving at their activities on time.

DISMISSAL

Parents are expected to have their child picked up at the dismissal time of each specialty class. According to Avenues policy, Primary Division students may not be on campus without supervision. Any Primary Division student not picked up within 15 minutes of activity dismissal will be taken to the After School Hub and a late fee of R\$60 will be applied. There is no exception to this policy (including advance phone calls).

If a student needs to wait for a specialty class or stay late after one (no later than 5:30 p.m.) he or she may go to PlayLab activities for a shorter period of time.

ABSENCES

Parents are reminded that the control of contagious illnesses in school depends on cooperation from home. Please do not send your child to after school if he or she is not feeling well. If your child should become sick or mildly ill during after-school, we will call home to have the child picked up from school.

MAKE UP CLASSES

If a child misses an after-school class due to illness or schedule conflict, we cannot offer a make-up class. If an after-school class must be canceled due to teacher absence, we will offer a make-up by extending future classes to make up the time.

Policies and Procedures

REGISTRATION

Registration for **specialty classes** is available on [OPEN](#), our community portal. Upon registration, you will receive an electronic confirmation. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. If a class is listed as full, please sign up for the wait list as we make every effort to open additional sections to meet demand. All classes are contingent upon enrollment and may be canceled prior to the first day if we do not reach the minimum enrollment. If a requested class is canceled, you will be notified via email. Online registration closes on August 22. If you have any questions, please email extensions-sp@avenues.org.

Private music lessons have a separate registration process and managed directly through Opus Music School. If you are interested in private music lessons, please email musiclessons-sp@avenues.org.

PlayLab can be registered through extensions-sp@avenues.org. Occasional visits must be scheduled at least one day advance through the same email.

BILLING

You will receive a *boleto* via email to be paid on the 5th of each month. If payment is not made by due date, your child may not be able to participate in After School classes the following month.

DROPPING CLASSES

If a family wishes to drop a class, they must email extensions-sp@avenues.org by the 20th of month. Lessons cancelled after the 20th of the month will be charged the following month.
