BUS RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✿ All Lower School children should be in the company of an adult or a high school student while waiting for the morning bus. In the afternoon, Lower School children should be met by an adult, or accompanied by a Middle School or Upper School student when descending at their stop. In case of an unforeseen problem where the adult is not at the stop to meet the bus, the child must **STAY ON THE BUS AND BE BROUGHT BACK TO THE SCHOOL** after the bus has finished its route to be picked up by the parents at the school. Please instruct your young children not to get off the bus if you or a baby-sitter/guardian is not there to pick them up!
- ✿ It is forbidden for Lower School students to sit in the first row of seats on the bus. Seating for Lower School students is from the back exit forward to row 2.
- ✿ There is a strict rule concerning the use of objectionable language on the bus. Any violation of this rule must be reported to the bus monitor or to Brenda Heussaff immediately.
- ✿ In the interest of safety, **ALL** students must be **seated and facing forward** with their **seat belts on** while the bus is moving.
- ✿ ******* Disruptive behavior can be dangerous! Any violation will be viewed as a serious offense. Repeat offenses will be cause for suspension or expulsion from the school bus.
- ✿ Once the bus doors are closed in the afternoon, students will not be allowed to board the bus. *It is strictly prohibited to run in the parking lot to catch the bus!* Students who miss the afternoon bus must check in with the school office and can take the late bus at 17:15.
- ✿ Food and drinks are **prohibited** on the bus. Trash should never be left on the bus. The drivers arrive with a clean bus and the children should leave a clean bus at the end of the route.
- ✿ The school is not responsible for items left on the bus; nevertheless, please contact us immediately 01.4112.8245, 01.4112.8659, or admissions@asparis.fr if your child leaves something on the bus and we will do our best to coordinate with the bus company to find the item. Please write your child(ren)'s name on backpacks, lunchboxes, sports bags, etc. to help us return found items to you.
- ✿ Enter the bus by the front door only.
- ✿ Please remember that the bus monitor is on the bus to assure that safety and correct behavior are observed. They are to be respected, as you would want them to respect you.

***** Any conduct which endangers the safety of students on the bus will result in a phone call and letter to the parents and the student being removed from the bus for a period of one week.**

All other violations of bus rules will result in a warning letter being sent to the parents outlining the student's behavior. After a second violation of the bus rules, the student will be removed from the bus for one week. Additional violations will result in additional suspension and/or permanent removal from the bus.

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TERMS OF BUS SERVICE

1. The school shall contract with transportation carriers to transport the children whose parents have requested school transportation for the school year indicated according to the conditions set forth below, and the fees as published on the fee schedule.
2. School transportation is understood to be the school bus as per the latest published schedule on all school days between the school and the stop indicated on the student bus card.
3. Only those children may use school transportation for whom a properly completed *TRANSPORTATION FORM* has been submitted.
4. Each child is required to use only his designated bus and stop. The school will not approve any change for a child under grade five unless it is indicated by written permission, email or letter to THE Admissions Office and Lower School child's teacher, that the child will be met at the temporary stop. In no case shall the school be responsible for a child who makes a change unless the above procedures are followed.
5. Each Lower School child, grades K1 through 5, must be accompanied to and met at the proper stop by one of his parents or another person authorized by the parents on every day he/she attends school.
6. The children should be at the designated stop five minutes prior to the scheduled departure time in the morning.
7. LATE BUS service is for students in grades 3 – 12 on Monday through Thursday and for students in grades 6 – 12 on those Fridays with scheduled service.
8. Children must behave responsibly whatever means of transportation they use.
9. The school reserves the right to suspend a child for cause from school transportation temporarily or for the remainder of the school year. Under such circumstances the transportation fee shall not be refunded.
10. Parents may not initiate technical changes, i.e. the location of a stop, but must request such changes through the Admissions Office.
11. Persons other than children in attendance at the school may not use school transportation without permission of the Admissions Office.
12. The school reserves the right to change routes, times or fees after due notice has been given to the parents.
