

Eton School 2018-2019 Fifth Grade Supply List

Required Materials

- 5 Mechanical Pencils with extra lead, and/or 10-15 Regular Pencils
- Erasers
- Colored Pencils
- Pencil Sharpener
- Colored Pens (*Need something other than black for marking assignments; having a variety of colors is fun, but not necessary.*)
- Flash drive (*1 GB is plenty. Ideally, this will be for school-use only; pictures, music, games, and other personal files should be stored elsewhere.*)
- 2 One-Inch Three Ring Binders** (*View binders that allow you to slip papers on the front, back, and side. It's also nice if they have hardcovers to double as solid writing surfaces.*)
- 6 Pocket Dividers with Tabs
- 2 Pocket Folders
- Loose-Leaf, Lined Paper, at Least 200 Sheets (*College Rule, or Standard if preferred.*)
- Pencil case
- Earphones or Earbuds (*To be left at school.*)
- Water bottle (*To be left at school.*)

Optional Materials

- Locker Shelf/Organizers (*The sturdier the better; free-standing shelves work well, while in contrast, the tension shelves almost always fall.*)
- Markers
- Sharpies or Other Permanent Markers (*Might be nice to have various colors, and/or thin and fine point sizes.*)
- Magnets (*For decorating or posting things on lockers. Stronger magnets are great, as weaker ones tend to fall when the lockers are opened and closed; tape, glue, and other adhesives may not be used on lockers.*)
- Card Stock, 110 Lb. (*Not necessary, but nice for some assignments.*)
- Geometry Set
- Tape and/or Glue

** For the way fifth grade is organized, the large, zipper binders that hold all subjects tend to overflow very quickly, and/or become heavy and unwieldy. If you prefer them, that's fine, but having two separate one-inch binders will probably be easier to use.
