**GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Any mandatory payment for student participation in a class, program, or activity is a fee and is subject to the fee waiver requirement.
  2. All fees listed are the maximum amounts charged per pupil for each class or school-sponsored or supported activity. Actual amount charged may be less.
  3. All students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss, breakage, or damage is not subject to the waiver requirement. Official transcript may be withheld if breakage, or damage costs are not paid in accordance with Utah Code Ann. §53A-11-806.
  4. Donations are permissible in both elementary and secondary schools, but all such requests are voluntary. A student may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not make a donation.
  5. The amount specified for uniforms, travel, and clinics in both junior and senior high school, is the total which may be spent whether from student contributions, fund raising activities, school subsidy or donation.
