

# LET'S GET READY TO WORK

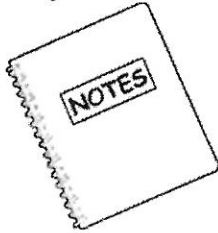
I put my pencil in the pencil box
