

**PAYMENT**  
Can be made in cash, by cheque (payable to CHENEFORD LTD, unless otherwise stated) or by credit/debit card (all major cards accepted) subject to a £1.00 handling charge on telephone.

**RESERVATIONS**  
Will be held for a maximum of 7 days or 30 minutes prior to the performance, whichever is sooner; after which they will be put back on sale.

**CONCESSIONS**  
Where applicable concessions apply to over 60's, under 18's and disabled patrons. Canford School Society members are entitled to a 10% discount on full price tickets.

**REFUNDS**  
We regret we are unable to exchange tickets or make any refunds unless a performance is cancelled. In the event of a sell-out a refund may be possible if we are able to re-sell tickets.

**STUDENT PRODUCTIONS**  
Admission to student productions is free but priority is given to parents, students and school staff.

**DISABLED PATRONS**    
We welcome patrons with disabilities and if you need assistance please let us know when you book your tickets. The theatre is fitted with an infra-red hearing system - please ask for details when booking. Other facilities include parking adjacent to the building, level access, disabled toilet and two designated wheelchair spaces. Guide and hearing dogs are welcome.
