Cedar Brook Elementary Uniform Policy 2018-19

Students may wear navy blue or khaki pants, shorts (boys & girls), skirts, skorts, Polo-dresses, and jumpers (girls). Girls may also wear leggings or tights under appropriate uniform bottoms (leggings should not be worn as pants). Students may wear red, white, light blue, navy blue or hunter green polos (logos should not be visible). Cedar Brook T-shirts may be worn instead, but other t-shirts are not permitted. Pants must be worn above the hipbone with a belt, if needed. Blue or black denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only (with a uniform polo or Cedar Brook t-shirt) and must fit—baggy or tight clothing is not permitted. Also, bottoms (shorts, Skirts, Skort, Polo-dresses, and jumpers) should not be too short and should pass the “hand test.” This means that when the student’s arms rest at her sides, the fingertips should not extend beyond the hem of the garment.

Allowable Dress (Do’s)

- Navy blue or Khaki pants, shorts (boys & girls) skirts, skorts, polo-dresses, jumpers (girls)
- Leggings or tights under appropriate bottoms (girls)
- Polo-type shirts (red, white, light blue, navy blue or hunter green)
- Any Cedar Brook Elementary T-Shirt
- Blue or Black Jeans with CBE or Polo-type shirt (Friday only)

Non-Allowable Dress (Don’ts)

- Baggy or tight clothing
- Bottoms that are too short (must pass the hand test)
- Oxford-type shirts
- Any other shirts or bottoms not listed in the Do’s section above
- *no flip-flops, shoes with wheels, or light effects.*
