Warrior Servant Leadership Program Commitment Form

The WSL Program is more than an opportunity for students to serve, but an attitude and commitment for the community of administrative staff, teachers, support staff, and students of Metrolina to follow the commands of the scripture and the model of Christ seen in Matthew 20:26-28. The WSL Program is a school wide pledge to create more opportunities for service and leadership in an effort to cultivate a lifestyle of service. The WSL Program is an investment of the heart with a single-minded purpose to serve, which is part of our Biblical responsibilities as we care for others and our community.

The WSL Program is open to all high school students. Any student interested in the program must sign the WSL Program statement of commitment, complete and submit the application, as well as participate in service and leadership opportunities that meet the requirements listed in the chart below. Participants must also attend monthly meetings which will be centered on the theme of servant leadership. **September 28th, 2018** is the deadline for submission of the application and signed statement of commitment form.

12th graders – 40 hours* of service from 3 venues

11th graders – 40 hours* of service from 3 venues

10th graders – 30 hours* of service from 2 venues

9th graders – 24 hours* of service from 2 venues

*this includes required Bible Service hours

In an effort to ensure accountability for all students who have committed to the WSL Program, students are required to submit completed service forms according to the following schedule –

- December 1st for all activities completed between June 1st – November 30th
- March 1st for all activities completed between December 1st – February 28th
- June 1st for all activities completed between March 1st – May 31st

The student who completes the WSL Program will receive recognition at graduation as well as qualify for the WSL Scholarship. Any student accepted into the WSL Program after Freshman year must provide evidence of completing the extra required service hours from the previous years not enrolled in WSL.
