## <u>TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM NEW YORK-AREA AIRPORTS</u> <u>AND NEW YORK CITY</u>

## I. TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM AIRPORTS

**STATE SHUTTLE** offers 24-hour service between campus and New York-area airports. The school rate (including gratuity) is as follows:

- \* NEWARK AIRPORT \$95.00 per person
- \* LAGUARDIA AIRPORT \$195.00 per person
- \* JFK AIRPORT \$195.00 per person

(These rates are subject to change during the school year.)

Arrangements for State Shuttle pick-up are coordinated by Blair's student life office. Please call (908) 362-6121, ext. 5605. Students must register their travel itineraries with the student life office at least 24 hours in advance of pickup. No payment is required at the time of the trip; billing will be handled by Blair's business office. Higher rates and a billing surcharge are likely for those making reservations directly with State Shuttle instead of working through the student life office.

When returning to School, students arriving at the airports should pick up their baggage, and then call the shuttle dispatcher at (800) 427-3207 to arrange curb-side pick-up.

At vacation times, the School will charter a bus to the Port Authority Bus Terminal and Newark Airport (\$35) if there are sufficient sign-ups. The chartered bus will depart from Blair between noon and 12:30 p.m. Flights departing from Newark after 3:30 p.m. are best to utilize the chartered bus. Students whose travel itineraries don't coincide with the time of the chartered bus will need to travel via State Shuttle.

## II. TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM NEW YORK CITY

MARTZ TRAILWAYS buses run between Stroudsburg/Delaware Water Gap (20 minutes from campus) and the Port Authority Bus Terminal several times each day. The School provides van service to and from Stroudsburg/DWG (\$18). Students must sign up in the student life office for transportation to and from Stroudsburg/DWG.
