



BEVENDEAN 'GREEN SCHOOL' POLICY

Aims:

- To recycle all paper, card and cardboard, plastic bottles, glass bottles, cans.
- Every classroom to have a green bin and children to be taught to separate waste and to conserve items wherever possible for re-use.
- To conserve energy in all areas of the premises – children to be taught about conserving heat, light etc.
- Children to be taught to understand the reasons and benefits of being “Green” – to be covered in Topic work and Circle Times where appropriate.
- To launch and run an Eco Warrior Committee within the school.

Points of action:

- To use less paper where possible, avoid wasting paper – teachers and children alike, recycling paper which may otherwise be discarded, photocopied sheets should be double sided for example and used only when necessary.
- To close classroom doors, windows during cold spells to conserve heat, outer doors to be closed.
- To turn off lights when leaving a room.
- To turn down heating when appropriate and wear a jumper or cardigan in the colder weather.
