



Behaviour of Children on School Buses

The following rules of conduct apply to all children who go on the school bus. Children must:

- Always listen to the driver and follow his instructions. This is a safety rule and must be adhered to at all times.
- Always wear a seatbelt on the coach or mini bus. There will be no exception to this rule.
- Conduct themselves in a quiet and considerate way, respecting the right of others not to be disturbed by their presence.
- Be polite at all times, both to the driver and to other children.
- Remain seated at all times

Pupils who do not behave in a safe, sensible and polite way on the school bus will be dealt with by the Deputy Headmaster and removed from the bus if necessary
