

Calculating GPA

Instructions for calculating your GPA

1. Fill in your grades in the Grade column below.
2. Use the chart to the right to put down the point value of each grade in the Points Earned column. For example, if you got a B in Chorus, you would put a 3 in the Elective Points Earned column.
3. Add up your total points earned and put the sum on the line marked Total.
4. Divide the Total by 6 and put that number in the box. That is your GPA!

If you would like to calculate your cumulative GPA, use the equation below. You will add all of your quarter GPAs, then divide by the number of the last quarter you completed. So if you are in third quarter and trying to find out your GPA, you will add up your first and second quarter GPAs, then divide by two since second quarter was the last one you completed.
