o We also reviewed last years school improvement plan

o There is not a set number of goals, but the district will be asking all schools to implement some district wide goals:

* District Goal #1: Increase the percentage of K-3 students at or above DIBELS end-of-year composite score benchmark from 40% to 48% (27 students).

* District Goal #2: Reduce the percentage of students who are chronically absent (10% or more days missed) from 16% to 14% (13 students).

* District Goal #3: Some sort of quality staffing goal

o We also discussed the school-wide goal of having all benchmark students remain at benchmark and students below benchmark will make progress toward benchmark.

o Trustland money will be about \$29,500 for 2015-16.

o We looked at our SAGE scores compared to other Title 1 schools. Math scores were above our peer schools. ELA and science were considerable below other Title 1 schools.

* Extended Day Kindergarten Schedule

o A team: Start of school to 1:25

o B team: 11:25 to the end of school
