

## The Durfee Bells

THE ORIGINAL CHIME OF BELLS, which hung in the clock tower of Rock Street's B.M.C. Durfee High School, was dedicated in 1887 to the memory of Bradford Matthew Chaloner Durfee, the only child of Bradford and Mary Brayton Durfee. Generations of Fall River students were called to homeroom by these bells, which chimed 29 times each morning to commemorate the age at which young Bradford died.
