### RETIREE HEALTH BENEFIT CHANGES

Currently, FUHSD acts as the Billing Agent & Health Benefits Officer for all district health benefits. This will continue for all retirees and current employee until Oct. 1, 2012.

Beginning now, CalPERS will act as the Billing Agent and Health Benefits Officer for all CalPERS medical benefits for retirees.

The District will continue to act in the same capacity for Dental & Vision for retirees and all other employee.

**All retirees will receive a letter directly from CalPERS that contains all of the information needed to enroll in health benefits.**

#### What does this really mean?

- All questions (rates, billing, health plans, etc.) should be made directly to CalPERS.
- All enrollments must be done directly through CalPERS.
- CalPERS will deduct the full cost of you health care premiums directly from your monthly CalPERS retirement check.
- FUHSD will send you a check each month for the cost of your **medical** benefits (maximum of \$755 prorated by your benefit FTE with Dental & Vision costs deducted, if needed).
