ITINERARY

Day 1 Friday, June 14, 2019

Depart the USA

Morning departure by deluxe WiFi Northfield Lines motor coach
from VISTA to Chicago O'Hare International Airport. Check in and fly
with Lufthansa Airlines overnight in your transatlantic flight to

Munich, Germany. The flight time is about 8-hours.

Day 2 Saturday, June 15, 2019

Tel Aviv Make a morning connection in Munich and continue to Israel.

Afternoon arrival at Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv. Meet your local tour manager and transfer to the hotel positioned along the Mediterranean coast. Enjoy a welcome buffet dinner.

Day 3 Sunday, June 16, 2019

Tel Aviv | Tiberias Start the day with a visit to Caesarea. See the Crusader and Roman remains and the harbor where St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Continue on to Haifa and Mt Carmel. Enjoy the spectacular view across the River Kishon, Haifa Bay and the northern region. Visit the cave where Elijah was fed by the ravens and the Church of Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery with the Madonna of Mt Carmel. Drive to Cana, site of Jesus's first miracle of turning water into wine and celebrate the renewal of marriage vows. Onto to nearby Nazareth, known as Jesus' town and see the Church of Annunciation and Mary's Well. Continue to Galilee for a 2-night stay.

Day 4 Monday, June 17, 2019

Galilee | Banias | Tiberias

Start the day with a boat ride across the scenic Sea of Galilee. See

Capernaum and the ancient synagogue where Jesus once
preached and the Church built over Peter's House. Continue on to
the Church of St. Peter's Primacy in Tabgha, the place where Jesus
empowered St Peter to be the Rock where He will build his Church.

At the Church of Tabgha is the ancient mosaic of the Loaves and
Fish. Nearby is Mt Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is
remembered. Here we will celebrate mass. In the afternoon we visit
Caesarea Philippi, location of the testimony of St. Peter and where
Jesus answered him "You are the Rock and upon this rock I will
build my Church." Return to Tiberias.

Day 5 Tuesday, June 18, 2019 Jordan Valley | Jerusalem Leaving the Sea of Galilee this morning you drive to Mt. Tabor and transfer to taxis for an exciting ride to the top of this mountain where tradition locates the site of the Transfiguration to celebrate Mass. Afterwards drive through the Jordan Valley and visit the Baptismal site beside the Jordan River, then up through the Judean hills to the Holy City of Jerusalem. Mass at Mt Tabor if you wish.

Day 6 Wednesday, June 19, 2019

Bethlehem | Jerusalem On the first day in Jerusalem we head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St John the Baptist and to the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. Continue to Bethlehem to visit the University, the only Catholic University in the Holy Land. In the afternoon we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Then we visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. We celebrate mass at the Nativity. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 Thursday, June 20, 2019

We begin our day on the Mt. of Olives to visit the Pater Noster with the Lords Prayer in many languages, and the Ascension from where Jesus ascended to Heaven. Walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Visit Gethsemane, the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest. Visit the cave of betrayal then the cave of the Assumption of Mary to heaven. Drive through the Kidron Valley to St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Christ three times. At the Cenacle we visit the Upper Room of the Last Supper and celebrate Mass. We finish the day at Dormition Abbey where we believe the Blessed Mary died. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 Friday, June 21, 2019 Jericho | Dead Sea | Jerusalem The desert east of Jerusalem is rich in Christian tradition. Further east, just off the Roman road that Jesus 'walked', is Wadi Qelt gorge, site of the Monastery of St George. At the oasis town of Jericho, visit the excavations of the oldest city in the world and view Mt. Temptation where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. On the way back there is time for a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. In the afternoon, there will be time for you to revisit some of your favorite sites and time for last minute souvenir shopping for your loved ones. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 9 Saturday, June 22, 2019 Tel Aviv | Depart to USA Early in the morning we retrace the last steps of Jesus. As we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow), through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Celebrate Mass at the Holy Tomb.

After breakfast at our hotel we return to the Old City of Jerusalem to visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents, Saints Joachim and Anne. We pass the Ecce Homo where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man"; then the Wailing Wall, the most holy place for Jews. Nearby is the Dome of the Rock and Temple Mount.

Continue to Tel Aviv and old city of Jaffa, one of the oldest port cities in the world and mentioned in the Book of Joshua as the border of the Tribe of Dan's territory. Today its cobbled alleyways are home to an artists' colony with galleries displaying local and foreign paintings and sculptures. Check into the hotel and have time to freshen up before a farewell dinner to conclude the tour.

Day 10 Sunday, June 23, 2019 Return to USA
Early morning flight on Swiss Air to Zurich where you make a
connection to Chicago O'Hare. Arrive in the early afternoon,
clear US Immigration/Customs and return to VISTA by
Northfield Lines motor coach. Evening arrival home. Inflight
