

# **BEYOND THE BUILDINGS**



#### **GYMNASIUM**

Serving as the headquarters for the Galloway Athletics & Kinetic Wellness (KW) Program, the gymnasium includes Dan Woolley Court, which is used for basketball

woolley Court, which is used to and volleyball practice and competition, and the Galloway weight room and athletic training room. The building is also home to administrative offices for the Athletics Department (2nd floor) and Kinetic Wellness staff (main level). Galloway's spirit wear (Gallowear) can be the store located in the gym lobby during athletic events.

#### **WARD LIBRARY**

Galloway's Ward Library is divarient two areas — one for Early Learning dents and the other for Middle and Upper

Learning students. It is designed as a learning commons that serves a wide variety of student needs, including opportunities to use new technologies, flexible and collaborative work spaces, and quiet study spaces.

## SIMS BUILDING EARLY LEARNING

All Early Learning classrooms, both regular and specialist, are contained within the Sims Building. Each classroom has natural light and access to the playground or the ABC, an

outdoor learning space that is used as an extension of the classroom.

# CHADDICK CENTER FOR THE ARTS

Chaddick Center for the Arts is the centerpiece of our campus – the building that brings our entire school community

together. The lobby serves as a gathering place that includes a student-run coffee ship liled Galloway Grounds, a technology help desk for students and teachers, and IDEA Lab. Chaddick includes the main theater and a black box theater/dance studio, visual arts studios, a choral and instrumental music suite, a recording studio, and a gallery space for student and community exhibitions.



The Chaddick Center is home to a 300-seat, state-of-the-art performance theater, which was designed by the same architectural firm that designed Spivey Hall, one of Atlanta's most highly acclaimed music performance venues.



## THE BLUE

The Blue is used for a variety of outdoor activities and gatherings. It is a primary hangout space for Middle Learning students during their free time before and after school and is also used for recess. Outdoor KW classes, sports practices, and various community celebrations are often heart of the Blue. It is also home to the Scots Shop.

# ATHLETICS COMPLEXES

Galloway operates two off-site athletics facilities. Located at 2400 Defoors Ferry Road, the Galloway Athletics Complex is a training facility and competition space for soccer and track and field. It also serves as a venue for other school-wide events including Elliott's Run. The Warren Road Complex is located just one-half mile away and serves as home to the softball and baseball teams.

## STONE HOUSE

The Stone House serves as the home of our world languages program. Spanish, French, and Latin classes are offered.

## GRESHAM BUILDING

MAIN ENTRANCE

The Gresham Building served as the original home for The Galloway School and is on the National Register of Historic Places. The Welcome Center is located just inside the front door, across the lobby from the meeting space called the "Think Tank." The head of school's office and the admissions office are also located in this area.

#### **CHASTAIN PARK**

The Galloway School is surrounded by Chastain Memorial Park, the largest city park in Atlanta. The 268-acre public park includes jogging paths, tennis courts, baseball fields, a golf course, swimming pool, a horse park, and an amphitheater. Galloway has an official partnership with Farm Chastain, the park's urban farm initiative.
