Thank you for considering volunteering at Snow Horse Elementary. Volunteers are valued members of our school community, and help us accomplish much more than we could without them! There are a number of things that you need to know in order to be most effective, to stay within the law, and for your own, and the students' protection.

1. Please do not bring preschool children to school with you when you volunteer. Many activities require your full attention; others involve equipment that may be dangerous to little ones. Teachers often have volunteer opportunities that can be accomplished at home, if you have small children.
2. As a Gold Medal School, we do not allow smoking on school grounds and we do not give food as a reward. Class parties and other celebrations need to have healthy alternatives when sweets are provided. Please do not make exceptions to these policies.
3. When there is an emergency drill, such as a fire drill, volunteers are required to exit the building with everyone else.
4. We require volunteers to check in at the office and wear a name-badge while working in the school.
5. Your dress should reflect the activity you will be involved with, but please conform to our dress code for students: no short shorts, revealing tank tops, etc. We appreciate your modeling modesty while working with children.
6. Working one on one with a student should only be done within the classroom, or in full view of others. Our commons areas are great for this purpose.

Please read the following Volunteer Agreement, sign below, and return it to the office. Volunteer hours are recorded, and help the school and the District in a number of ways, including obtaining grant money. Please be sure to check out through the office, to ensure these hours are recorded.
