III. Goal Summary Statement

Students will improve the ability to select materials appropriate to their reading ability and interest in using a current, well-developed library collection.

IV. Full Goal Description

Research demonstrates that students select more appropriate reading materials and become more engaged with reading when current, attractive and diverse materials are available. Developing a collection includes selection of materials according to DSD District LM Policy and school guidelines AND the weeding of materials that are no longer current, attractive or being used by students.

Librarians need to select either *Selection* or *Weeding* and determine the Action Steps necessary to meet the determined target.

For Example:**Who:**

Librarian at Always Reading Elementary School

Goal:

Weeding the Collection

Action Steps:

Each Friday, weed one shelf in the library.

Delete copy from Destiny Catalog.

Remove barcodes, spine labels and stamp as "No Longer Property of..." or remove covers to throw away and recycle the book.

Target:

Complete weeding of fiction titles.
