

Hilltop Pick-Up Procedures and Safety Reminder

- Our Hilltop loading zone begins at the edge of the parking lot, past the baseball field, well in sight of our staff. Only students who walk home may venture beyond the loading zone.
- Please pull all of the way forward into the start of the loop, so we may load as many cars as possible. Do not stop at the intersecting sidewalk. Your child will follow you.
- Merging into the Front pick up line is prohibited between the hours of 7 -7:40 AM and 2:15-2:55 PM. (drop off and pick up times) All cars must take the loop and exit back out Hilltop.
- Hilltop Pick-up is a two lane, two-way road. Please do not pass on the left into the oncoming lane to skip in line.
- Please do not double park to pick up students.
