ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Spring Lake Park High School is on a Trimester System. One credit is given per class per trimester. Students have honors and AP options beginning in ninth grade in all of the core course subject areas, including language arts, social studies, math, science and world language. Total credits needed is 64. Credits required for graduation:

12 Language Arts	2 Physical Education
12 Social Studies	1 Health
9 Science	3 Visual or Performing Arts
9 Math	16 Electives

College Credit Options

Several courses taught at Spring Lake Park High School offer students both high school and college credit. Students are expected to perform at the college level. Students will receive a Certificate of Credit if they meet the college credit requirements.

Opportunities in Emergency Care

OEC is an award-winning medical education program. We offer extensive opportunities to students interested in serving others in the healthcare field. We teach Emergency Medical Services programs to regional high school students and offer continuing education for adults.

Students can learn basic First Aid, or become fully prepared to pursue careers in clinics, hospitals, nursing homes, in-home healthcare, ambulance services, fire departments and more. We offer courses in First Aid & CPR, Emergency Medical Responder, Emergency Medical Technician, Nursing Assistant – Registered, Self Defense and Medical Internship programs.

Students can earn college credits and/or their National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician certification, which enables them to pursue careers in various EMS and healthcare professions. Based in Spring Lake Park High School, we educate in-district, as well as out-of-district students from many other regional high schools.

AVID

AVID is a global nonprofit organization dedicated to closing the achievement gap by preparing all students for college and other postsecondary opportunities. AVID supports the district's vision of college readiness for each student, and the ultimate end goal of having each student complete 12 college credits by the end of 12th grade (12x12). The skills learned through AVID will contribute to student success in rigorous coursework that results in college credit, including Anoka Ramsey Community College courses offered at the high school, Advanced Placement courses, College in the Schools courses, and career and technical education articulation agreements.

TESTING

ACT

- 78% of the class of 2016 took the ACT
- The average ACT score is 20.7
- No information is available for the SAT due to the small number of students who take this exam
- 18% of our students in 2016 took the PSAT exam with two students receiving the Semifinalist Honor

- A total of 565 AP exams were taken in 2016. One student was recognized as an AP Scholar with Distinction, three students were recognized as AP Scholars with Honor and seven students were recognized as AP Scholars.
