Updated on staffing for next year, with the opening of Centerview Elementary. Presented current projected teacher placements for Northpoint- what teachers are staying, what teachers are moving grades, and what teachers are moving schools. Due to continued internal and external hires that are taking place in the district, staffing has not been finalized and therefore a detailed staff list is was not available at the PTO meeting for review. Continue to check the Northpoint Newsletters and Spring Lake Park School district for the most up-to-date information

Highlights from staffing: Principal Judi Kahoun and the front office team will all be returning to Northpoint. There will be one center-based ASD/EBT class. The district has hired a STEM specialist for each school. Grades will no longer be divided between east and west pods. Kindergarten will continue to be split up and there will be one preschool class at Northpoint. Again, continue to check back for the most up-to-date information.

Question presented by parent: Will class sizes changes or stay the same? Per Principal Kahoun, class sizes will stay about the same/ within district guidelines. However, finalization of classroom lists for next year will be occurring over the next few weeks.
