In preparation for the Junior Guidance presentation, we would like you to work on an activity prior to us coming in. The purpose the activity is to start giving you the **skills** you need to research colleges and their application requirements.

Step 1 (**at home**): Complete a college search on Naviance to get a list of colleges that may be a good fit.

Step 2 (at home if you have time): From your list of results, pick 1 UC school , 1 CSU school , 1 Private School, and 1 Out-of-State Public school and research their application requirements. Fill out the 2nd page of the packet titled "College Search Activity (Juniors)"

Our goal is that you will complete as much as possible, so we can spend time talking about the areas where you got stuck or had questions. Don't worry if you're still not sure about your major or what colleges you are interested in. The purpose of the activity is to teach you the *skills* to research any school, not to build your college list.
