HOW WILL WE IMPROVE?
Schoolwide Strategies: Math: Parks Middle utilizes Eureka Math and IReady programs to teach Louisiana State Grade Level Standards for Math. ELA: Parks Middle utilizes LDOE Guidebook and IReady programs to teach Louisiana State Grade Level Standards for Reading/ELA.
SCHOOLWIDE PLAN GOAL 3 (for ALL Non-Proficient Subgroups) WITH OBJECTIVES
Subgroup Goal: Our school has no sub-groups that were identified by the state as being in need of intensive support. Parks Middle staff will monitor student progress and provide support to struggling students as needed.
HOW WILL WE IMPROVE?
Schoolwide Strategies: Parks Middle stakeholders will analyze data to determine which students are students having academic deficiencies and provide intervention based on need. Response to Intervention strategies reflective of the following: RTI Tiers 1-3 Interventions, READ180/S44, I-Ready, Computer lab, 1:1/small group tutoring intervention and Gator Gain. The intervention will take place during both classroom instruction and Gator Gains Remediation. Students who are not successful with classroom interventions will receive more intensive classroom interventions which will include tutoring or I-Ready interventions.
SCHOOLWIDE PLAN GOAL 4 DISCIPLINE/NON-ACADEMIC WITH OBJECTIVES
NON-ACADEMIC Goal: Parks Middle’s mission is to provide students with necessary tools need to utilize positive cope and problem solving strategies. As a result, Parks Middle will utilize PBIS, procedures and conflict resolutions strategies to support a safe and orderly learning environment. our school goal is to reduce the number of behavior referrals (including classroom referrals) by 5%.
HOW WILL WE IMPROVE?
Schoolwide Strategies: Key stakeholders at Parks Middle, consistently implement and adhere to our school wide PBIS and Discipline Plan. Students who consistently adhere to PBIS plan and make good choice will receive daily Gator Bucks and monthly incentive rewards. Parents will be notified of any behavior concern Parents will receive . School-wide Positive Behavior and Intervention Supports will be utilized. Students will be rewarded with “tiger paws” and receive monthly school-wide incentives.
