Online Application Process:

Notre Dame High School encourages all qualified young men to create an admissions account at www.notredamehs.com/admissions. Once students create an Online Admissions account they can:

- n Register for a KNIGHT For A Day (shadow visit) / Interview.
- n Register for the admissions test (only for grade 9 applicants).
- n Submit an application.
- n Check the status of their application.
- n Receive notifications from Notre Dame throughout the Admissions process.

For students that are in 6th and 7th grade we encourage you to submit an online inquiry to receive information regarding upcoming events, it's never too soon to explore why Notre Dame is the right school for you!

Online Financial Aid Process:

Students may also apply for financial aid online at www.notredamehs.com/tuitioninformation. Notre Dame will utilize the online service of FACTS Management to process applications for the 2018–19 school year. All applications must be submitted using the FACTS website (link provided above).

FACTS does not decide whether financial assistance will be given or how much to give; rather FACTS provides a need-based financial aid analysis service which includes a recommendation of what a family should reasonably contribute toward tuition. All information from FACTS is kept confidential. The Financial Aid Committee will make Financial Aid offers based on the amount of Aid available for the 2018–19 school year. Upon approval by the Committee, financial aid offers are then sent to families.

If families have limited access to computers the Admissions Office would be happy to help with the paper application process.
