## Reading Contest

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## Field Trip

Mr. noun1's (noun) class is going on a/an adj1 (adjective) trip to the toy noun2 (noun) factory. Each student will need to wear adj2 (adjective) shoes, so that they can verb1 (verb) on the trip without verb2 (verb, -ing).
