1. Members were introduced. List of members was passed around for proofreading. Travis Lund and Maren Hansen will not be voting members this year since some of our parents are district employees and we need to have more parent voting members than employees.

3. Chair and Vice-chair were elected for 2017-2018. Laura Gabel will continue as chair and Elaine Oaks will serve as vice-chair.
4. Student Body President's report – Sophie Caligiuri
Homecoming week just ended. WX won the homecoming game and the dance had a good turnout. Football game this Friday vs. Bountiful. Sadie's dance will be early November this year. November will also bring the service dinner which will involve all clubs. Sophie will have more info at next meeting. Neighborhood house service project will also be held in December. 5. Principal Report – John Haning

Talked about how students and teachers have gone the extra mile to make school run as smooth as possible during the construction. The multi-purpose room is now available for kids to eat during lunch. Classrooms are up and running for the most part. Construction crews completed 6-8 months' worth of work during the summer.

Mr. Haning talked about Sage scores. They are posted on Community Council link on web site under Data sources. School received a B score, and dropped 55 points from last year which is the most in the district. Administration is looking at causes and solutions. There was discussion about the miscommunication that led staff to believe that the Sage test was not going to be used. More

students opted out and many did not take it seriously. Specific information about the test will be coming from the district in the next couple of weeks. Members were encouraged to look at the scores for future discussion.

6. Comprehensive Guidance Report – Pat Limas

Counselors have been busy with class changes and CCR's for sophomores. Utah High Ed day was held last week and was successful. New student lunch was held and about 30 student attended. There was also a lunch for new teachers. There was a meeting with seniors during flex and senior CCR's are currently taking place. Parent University was held during Parent Teacher Conferences. FAFSA night will be held October 5th for seniors. Higher Ed will focus on juniors and seniors in February or March.
