APPROVED USES OF PERSONAL MOBILE DEVICES

More and more students are requesting to use personal mobile devices (here defined as laptops, tablets, e-readers and phones) in the classroom. While we believe that the proper application and use of technology can enhance a student's ability to learn, devices can also be a distraction to not only the user but to those around him/her. We increasingly are utilizing technology in our instruction and giving students some flexibility to employ those devices broadens the opportunities for students to succeed. In order to promote learning for individuals and to maintain the proper classroom environment, we have implemented the following policy for student-owned devices.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. *Permission to use a personal mobile device must be specific to a particular subject and teacher.* In other words, the teacher agrees that using the device is important for the students to meet with success in that class. The teacher will also specify the type of uses that will be allowed for each student.
2. Either a student or a teacher can initiate the process for permission to use a device. *Students must go to the teacher to initiate permission.*
3. Each device must be registered and approved by the school. Approved devices may only be used for specific instructional purposes. The Principal holds final approval for all uses. Registration terms can be accessed from Mrs. Beall's desk.
4. Student devices may only be used in approved classrooms. They may not be accessed in unapproved classrooms, the hallways, bathrooms, or outside the building.
5. Only the student who owns the device may use the device. No sharing.
6. At this time, student devices will not be allowed to access the internet either through the school's service or through 3G or 4G networks unless a teacher gives the student specific permission to do so.
7. Student devices must be brought into school fully charged; if the battery runs out during the school day the device must be put away.
8. School staff will not attempt to fix any device that stops working. The school will not store student devices at any time.
9. The school assumes no responsibility for the loss of, theft of, or damage to any personal device or any information on that device.
10. The school reserves the right to examine any device and search its contents if there is a reason to believe that the school policies and guidelines have been violated.
11. Use of the device for purposes other than what is expressly permitted will result in discipline, which depending on the severity of the infraction, could result in loss of privilege of the device or far more serious punishment.
