II Lisa Weir explained MPAT

III Chromebook Rollout

- Pioneering digital resource (Chromebooks) for students
- Parents have been very pleased
- Go Guardian filters inappropriate material on campus and at home, message is sent to principal; APs and families are contacted
- Cell phone less of a distraction with Chromebook access

IV itslearning & Advisory

- Advisory for Social emotional work, T24 work, assemblies etc
- Advisory lessons are now in itslearning
- Teachers are in year 3 of implementation of itslearning and its going strong
- With Chromebooks in Advisory, students can link PSAT scores with Khan Academy through College Board account
- Create intro to itslearning for new enrollees was suggested
- Stampede helps with login issues before school starts
- We will be developing processes for issuing login credentials to parents
- Parents should use itslearning for the calendar and to view resources, but use Skyward for grades

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V Safety & Security

- For safety reasons, there are only 2 entrances to campus now: one in front and one in back
- Classroom doors are kept locked
- Halls are to remain clear at all times
- Drills are conducted each month at various times
- Visitors are badged in main office
- Every HS campus has a full time police officer and one more will be hired
- SafeSchool training prepares staff to recognize students who are in crisis
- Wellness counselors (2) are on staff
- Lunch vendors are vetted for security, drivers are background checked; they do not exchange cash; vendors are not allowed passed the bus circle
