## Doctor of Occupational Therapy Faculty

The Department of Occupational Therapy at Wingate University is excited to announce the opportunity to serve as a founding faculty member for the new entry-level Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) program slated to begin in August 2019. We invite applications for two 12-month, non-tenure track Assistant/Associate/Professor positions. Faculty members will develop and teach courses within the OTD curriculum, serve as a mentor for student research and doctoral capstone projects, advise students, and assist with ACOTE accreditation as a full member of the faculty team.

Qualified applicants will:

1. Have earned an entry-level occupational therapy degree and must possess an earned doctorate in occupational therapy or a related area (OTD, PhD, EdD, DSc, etc.) from a regionally accredited institution.
2. Be licensed as an occupational therapist in North Carolina (or eligible for licensure upon hire).
3. Have a minimum of 5 years of clinical practice as an occupational therapist with emphasis on adult and/or older adult conditions and rehabilitation.
4. Have 1 year of teaching experience.
5. Preferred applicants will show expertise in developing, conducting, and overseeing research and/or doctoral capstone projects.
6. Demonstrate excellent organizational and communication (written and oral) skills, and a commitment to student success.
7. Display initiative and a desire for professional learning and growth.
8. Show excellent problem solving, critical thinking, time management, and leadership skills.
9. Possess knowledge and skills associated with standard office software (Microsoft Word, Excel, etc.)
