Your senior year is quickly approaching, and the time has come to think about your senior yearbook photograph. Below is important information about your senior photo and senior salutes for the 2017 – 2018 school year! Senior photos can be expensive, so we have scheduled Shannon Surratt Photography to come to Edison to take high quality senior photos here at Edison during the senior photo dates listed below. If you intend to use another outside professional photographer, please read and follow the following guidelines carefully.

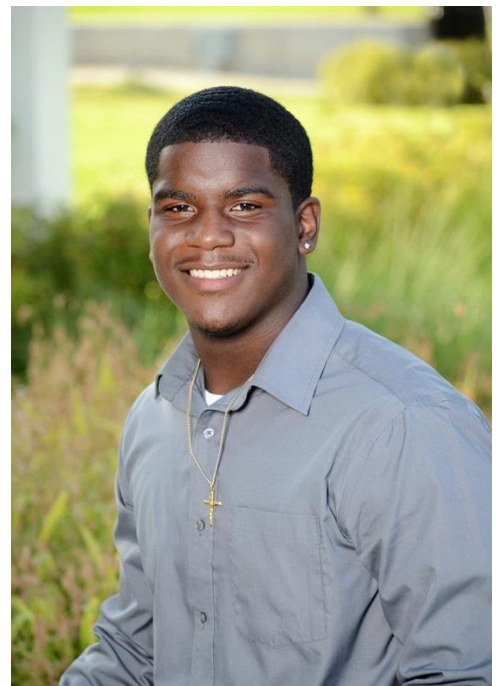
Senior Photo Pictures at Edison during English classes:

- **Monday, October 8 for AM English Classes/ Tuesday, October 9 for PM English Classes – Mr. Vinyard has agreed to allow seniors to wear their senior photo attire to school. Please see stipulations below for appropriate senior photo attire. Seniors will go to shooting location on the Edison campus during English classes.**
- **Tuesday, October 16, 2018 (MAKE UP DATE) – Seniors needing retakes may change into their senior attire for photo shoots. Shannon Surratt Photography will be stationed outside the main office from 3rd hour through 5th hour ONLY. Please see Mrs. Smith for a pass to leave class if you do not have English during those times.**

- **Free Sitting**
- **Natural Background on Edison Prep grounds**

Senior Photos MUST MEET the following specifications to be included in the senior portrait yearbook:

SUBMIT ONE PHOTO THAT MEETS THE FOLLOWING SPECIFICATIONS:

- **ATTIRE:**
 - Girls: Modest dress or top. No strapless or spaghetti strap, and no cleavage. Clothing should be in accordance with **SCHOOL DRESS CODE (BUSINESS CASUAL) OR DRESSIER**. No sports or band uniforms.
 - Guys: Wear a collared shirt. A t-shirt may only be worn if also wearing a collared jacket, blazer, or sweater. Clothing should be in accordance with **SCHOOL DRESS CODE (BUSINESS CASUAL) OR DRESSIER**. No sports or band uniforms.
 - No props of any kind – band instruments, footballs, soccer balls, etc.
- **DIGITAL IMAGE SPECIFICATIONS:**
 - **Saved on a CD, at 300 dpi, in JPEG format**
 - Photo dimensions of 2-1/2”(width) by 3-1/2” (height) with a face size of 1- 1/4 inch from top of the head to bottom of the chin; space from the top of the head to the top of the photo should no more than 1/2 inch; See photo examples included here in this document.



- **Portrait Orientation**
 - **No color filters of any kind**
 - **SAVE IMAGE AS: Last name, First name** (for example: Roberts, Jane); this name will appear on the yearbook senior portrait page
 - **LABEL THE CD with the first and last name of SENIOR and PROFESSIONAL STUDIO/ PHOTOGRAPHER'S NAME on the outside of the CD AND on the CD cover**

- **POSE SPECIFICATIONS:**
 - Students should be in an upright position, eyes and face directed to the camera (NO SIDE PROFILES), body should be angled slightly left or right with hands in lap or on knees.
 - Both shoulders must be visible.
 - Photo should be cropped to just below the chest.
 - Hands should not be visible.
 - No props should be visible.
 - No awkward or unusual facial expressions (i.e. crossed eyes, no tongues, goofy looks, etc.)
 - The photo should be formal and school appropriate.

- **BACKGROUND SPECIFICATIONS:**
 - Shots must be taken in **natural light with natural backgrounds** so the focus of the shot remains on the senior
 - No backlighting; no color filters of any kind; make sure the senior remains the focus and not bright lights from behind the subject that distract the attention away from the senior

- **ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:**
 - **IF PHOTOS ARE NOT RECEIVED BY THE November 1st DEADLINE, THE PHOTO SHANNON SURRATT PHOTOGRAPHY TAKES OF SENIORS HERE AT SCHOOL WILL BE USED IN THE YEARBOOK ON THE SENIOR PORTRAIT PAGES.**
 - **No watermarks or photographer's logos on the pictures.**
 - Photo submitted should include the **SENIOR SUBJECT ONLY**. Photos of seniors with band instruments, in sporting uniforms, with best friends and pets are appropriate for Senior Salute ads, so consider purchasing one! These photos will not be accepted for the senior portrait pages.
 - Photos should be **TAKEN WITH A DIGITAL CAMERA** by a professional photographer.
 - **Low resolution, low quality photos, or photos captured screen shot will be rejected, and the senior photo taken at school will be used on the senior portrait pages.**
 - Consider scheduling your session with Shannon Surratt Photography over the summer 😊



PHOTOS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FROM AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHERS. Due to photo quality issues, photos will no longer be accepted as an outside photographer unless the photo is taken with a professional studio. If a CD is provided that does not have a legitimate, professional studio name on it, it will be rejected. We will check all studio names. If any of the above specifications are not met, photos will not be accepted, and your senior photo taken at school will be used on the senior portrait pages.
