2. Principal's Report/ Dee Burton
Boys Basketball (At the time of the meeting, had just won the first playoff round. They continued to win on Thursday and were defeated on Friday by Lone Peak). The debate team won Region for the 12th year in a row. Debate has a very long season from Oct to March. Spring sports are in full swing. Soccer – will play all home games on the football field this year. This will be helpful in many respects. Wrestling took 7th in State; we will have the most boys ever returning next year. We had a sophomore take state in his weight. Dance Company had their state festival on Feb. 8th Davis received the highest, all superior ratings. Several students were offered scholarships.
Footloose begins on Friday March 7th through March 15th. Kim Call, one of our math teachers, received the District Care Award. She was one of 10 throughout the District to receive this award. Kim has also been very helpful in developing the common core curriculum and sends it out to other teachers to use each day. We have several teachers that will be retiring this year.
