### Monday: **BACK TO THE FUTURE**

- ★ Freshmen and Seniors wear "Space" apparel such as neon colors, silver and Star Wars space themed t-shirts.
- ★ Sophomores and Juniors wear "50's and 70's" apparel such as poodle skirts, rolled up jeans, flower power, peace signs, and bell bottoms.

### Tuesday: **PAJAMA DAY**

- ★ Bring out those footed pjs and bathrobes!
- ★ Please be tasteful in your choice of attire. No short shorts or sleeveless shirts may be worn.

### Wednesday: **MASS DAY**

## Homecoming Dance Dress Code

Our young men are expected to wear dress pants, dress shirts and ties. Jeans or shorts may not be worn. Our young women are expected to wear dressy, semi-formal or formal dresses. Dresses should be tasteful and appropriate for high school. This means no plunging necklines, inappropriate cut-outs or excessively short dresses. ## Homecoming Dance Details

- ★ Tickets will be on sale all week September 17-21st during Empower Hour. Purchases can be made in the small gym. Ticket cost - \$25 (includes a tshirt), please make checks payable to SDHS.
- ★ If you are inviting someone from another school you must fill out the guest form completely and have it with you in order to buy their ticket. Forms are located in the school office.
- ★ For the dance, students should enter through the Fallon Family Center outside doors and check in with the teachers at the front tables. Doors open at 7:00 p.m. The dance ends at 10:00 p.m.
- ★ Students may arrive any time between 7:00 and 8:00 p.m. Students will NOT be admitted in after 8:00 p.m.
- ★ The coronation is set for 8:45 p.m.
- ★ Parents are welcome to attend the coronation. Enter through the Fallon Family Center doors. You may view the event on the mezzanine.
- ★ Students choosing to leave the dance at any point after the coronation will NOT be admitted back into the dance.
- ★ Students who do not drive to the dance need to be picked up promptly at 10:00 p.m.
