

Community Council – Monday, September 10, 2018 - 4:00 PM

Introductions were made.

Roberts Rules of Order (information contained within the CC Binders)

1. procedure for all meetings reviewed
2. meeting information needs to be posted on the Sand Springs website 1 week in advance
3. minutes of meetings are taken and retained for 3 years
4. adherence to the mandated timeline provided by the district
5. members – 3 school employees, 9 parent members, principal
6. Chair conducts the meeting – a parent must hold this position
7. Vice-Chair is also a parent
8. quorum is required to vote
9. if a member misses 2 meetings, that member will be replaced
10. simple rules of parliamentary procedure will be followed – reviewed with those in attendance

Jody nominated Nicki Killpack as Chairman, the nomination was seconded by RaeAnn, passed unanimously.

Cheryce nominated Laurie Coleman as Vice-Chairman, the nomination was seconded by RaeAnn, passed unanimously.
