School Improvement Plan Review: A discussion was held on our current SIP and how we are seeing the positive outcomes of the plan and areas where we can be looking to further improve on. ACT prep is strongly being encouraged for students. Getting the word out to all students to utilize the results in canvas from the free ACT test they were given in October. How can we get the word out and strongly encourage students to study/review just 5 questions a day? The February ACT test for juniors will now require the writing portion to be completed. Maybe a presentation at the FAFSA help night in December will help get the word out.

We also saw an 11% increase in Sophomore Sage scores from last year.
