Senior Year Calendar 2018-19

August

- August 1st, UC Application available
- August 20th, 1st day of School
- Research colleges and narrow down list to 6-10 schools
- Compile a resume of activities, honors, leadership & work experience
- Work on your Brag Sheet in Naviance
- Decide on your college essay topics

September

- September 4th/ 5th Guidance presentation in Gov/Econ classes
- September 6th, Senior Parent/Student Meeting @ Back to School Night
- Register for the SAT Reasoning and/or SAT Subject Tests (Sept. 7th deadline for Oct. 6th test)
- September 12th, Private College Application Workshop 10:40am (MANDATORY FOR ALL STUDENTS CONSIDERING EARLY ADMISSIONS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS OR OUT OF STATE SCHOOLS)
- September 14th, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA
- September 20th, 6:00pm-8:00pm Attend the FUHSD College Fair @ HHS
- September 26th, Private College Application Workshop 10:40am (MANDATORY FOR ALL STUDENTS CONSIDERING ADMISSIONS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS OR OUT OF STATE SCHOOLS)
- September 28th, Early Admissions Senior Folders due (private/out of state deadlines on or before Nov. 15th)
- Register for the ACT (Sept. 28th deadline for Oct. 27th test)
- Begin compiling college applications
- Review your high school transcript for credits and college entrance requirements
- Ask for recommendation letters from teachers if applying to private colleges

October

- October 1st, CSU applications available for submission
- File FAFSA (between October 1 and March 2nd)
- October 3rd, CSU Application Workshop (flex time, Cafeteria)
- October 5th, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA
- Register for the SAT Reasoning and/or SAT subject tests (Oct. 5th deadline for Nov. 3rd test)
- October 6th, Take the SAT Reasoning and/or SAT Subject Tests, if necessary
- October 10th, UC Application Workshop (flex time, Cafeteria)
- October 17th, College Essay Workshop (flex time, Cafeteria)
- October 25th, Financial Aid Presentation by Financial Aid experts for Senior Parents (6:30pm)
- October 26th, Regular Admissions Senior Folders due (private/out of state deadlines after Nov. 15th)
- Take ACT, if necessary (Oct. 27th)
- Submit early decision/early action applications (most are due in the 1st week of Nov.)

November

- November 1st, UC applications available for submission
- November 2nd, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA
- Register for the SAT Reasoning, if necessary (Nov. 2nd deadline for Dec. 1st test)
- Register for the ACT, if necessary (Nov. 2nd deadline for Dec. 8th test)
- November 8th, attend Cash for College Night (assistance with FAFSA submission)
- Take the SAT Reasoning and/or SAT Subject Tests, if necessary (Nov. 3rd)
- November 9th, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA

- November 16th, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA
- November 30th, Open Lab College App Support FLEX TIME CAFETERIA
- Finalize college admissions essays
- Complete CSU and UC applications (deadline is Nov. 30)
- Send SAT/ACT scores to your colleges
- Check for deadlines on housing applications and supplemental financial aid forms

December

- For private schools, schedule interviews, if necessary
- Begin researching scholarships
- Last chance to take the SAT/ACT's for many colleges (Dec. 1st SAT /Dec. 8th ACT)
(Please note the Dec. test date is too late for some universities, as they will only accept up to Nov.)
- Study for finals (Senior year grades are important!)

January

- January 8th/9th College & Career Center in Gov/Econ classes for Financial Aid & Naviance
- January 10th, attend Cash for College Night (assistance with FAFSA submission)
- Continue researching scholarships
- Request that mid-year grade reports be sent to your colleges, if needed
- Complete housing applications (if necessary)

February - April

- File the FAFSA, if you haven't already (due March 2nd)
- Complete the GPA Verification form (due March 2nd)
- Verify that your application file is complete with each college
- Register for AP exams (March)
- March 21st Community College Night at 6pm
- Apply for all scholarships for which you qualify
- Decision letters begin arriving (April)
- Financial aid offers arrive (April - June)
- Compare financial aid offers
- Send housing deposit
- Attend Community College Night (TBD)

May

- Make final decision and send in a deposit (due May 1st)
- Take AP exams (if necessary)
- Check for college placement exams times and dates

June

- Request final transcript be sent to your college through your senior checkout survey
