A **typical chess club session** will consist of several of the following: a chess lesson, challenge games, workbook exercises, tournament preparation and fun play.

Certified chess instructors from *The Kansas City Chess Club* will be teaching players about important rules, chess etiquette, strategy, openings, endgames, and tactics. Research says chess improves test scores on Math and Reading.
